<u>General Rules</u>: The event will be held according to the offical rules of the OSV (Austrian Swimming Federation) and the FINA (International Swimming Federation). In the same time the Austrian Championships in Open Water Swimming will be held and in the junior class I and II.

<u>Registration-, Participation- and Start Reglementations :</u> according § 7 and § 10 of the general rules of the OSV.

According the age-reglementations of the FINA for open water events your are only allowed participate if you are of an age of 15 years.

With the official registration of the respective club/asscociation you prove that your athlete fullfills all sport health requirements for open water events and that this analysis is not older than 12 month of the registration deadline.

Concerning swimming suits the actual rules of the FINA for open water are valid. (Neoprene suits are strictly fobidden).

To wear swim-caps is obligatory – their will be provided from the event organiser and distributed during the bib-number distribution.

Transponder: All participants needs to wear transponders – you will receive them during the bibnumber distribution for a deposit of € 30,-- per transponder. The deposite will be refunded after the event by retourning the transponder. To start without a transponder is not allowed!
